## With 68, Lutz grabs Middle Amateur title

Ignited by five birdies in the first nine holes, Berkshire Country Club's Chip Lutz shot 31-37—68 yesterday at Talamore at Oak Terrace Country Club and won the Golf Association of Philadelphia's Middle Amateur championship.

Lutz, who finished with six birdies in his 3-under-par round, enjoyed a 2-stroke margin of victory over Saucon Valley's Robin McCool in a field of 144 amateurs 30 and older on the 6,598-yard layout in Ambler.

Defending champion Frank McFadden of Overbrook carded a 79.
